I. AADHAR REHABILITATION AND DEVELOPMENT CENTRE

For Intellectually / Mentally Challenged, Hearing Impaired, Hyper-Active, Autistic, Cerebral Palsy, Learning Disabled, Language Disabled, Blind, Visually Impaired & Multiple Disabled Children.

"ARDC" have launched this project in 15 April 2011 with three Children. Today we have 42 regular children on our rolls. We provide therapy and other rehabilitation services to more than 50 special children who come after the school hours and under community based rehabilitation/ home bound programme at their door step.

Services / Facilities Available

- ✓ Special Education and Training
- ✓ Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy
- ✓ Auditory Training and Speech Therapy.
- ✓ Training for Daily Living Skills as Brushing, Eating, Wearing Clothes / Shoes, Bathing, Toileting etc.
- ✓ Behavior Modification Services against Abnormal Behavior as Biting, Hurting - Self or Others, Head Banging, Excessive Crying, Disobedience, Hyper-active etc.
- ✓ Early Identification and Intervention Programme for 0-6 age groups.
- ✓ Pre-Vocational and Vocational Training.
- ✓ Special Olympics Type Games & Sports Training and Yoga.
- ✓ Special Celebrations as Holy & Idd Milan, Republic Day, Independence Day, Teachers Day, Deepawali, Relevant International Days, Christmas Day etc.

II. EARLY IDENTIFICATION & INTERVENTION

Early intervention therapy mainly focuses on the children between the age group of 0-6 years. It is a process of detecting, assessing, diagnosing and treating the children with developmental delay during the early phase. Early intervention services cater to children 0-6 years who are at risk or have developmental delays. These services focus on prevention, remediation, and treatment to foster all round development. The services offered are child centred and family oriented and provided by a multi-disciplinary team of experts. Early intervention therapy is a very helpful treatment programme because it targets on teaching proper skills during initial phase. We provide these services to more than 15 Special Children.

III. COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION PROGRAMME

The organization is running the Community Based Rehabilitation programme for Persons with Disabilities. In this programme the trained staff members of the organization visit the Persons with Disabilities at their door step and provide Guidance, Counseling and Training to their parents and other Community Members and motivate them to look after the PWDs. The main objective of this programme is the social inclusion and mainstreaming of the PWDs.

IV. AWARENESS, COUNSELLING, GUIDANCE & ADVOCACY PROGRAM

AADHAR FOUNDATION provide Awareness, Counselling, Guidance and Advocacy to Persons with Disabilities and their parents for the rights and entitlements of the Persons with Disabilities as Education Right, Reservation Quota in Govt. Jobs, Pension, Barrier Free Environment, Scholarship, Certification, Identity Cards, Traveling Concession Certificates, and other rights according to the PWDs Act 1995. The main objective of this programme is to make them self reliant and self dependent to live their lives with honour and dignity.

• PROGRAMME FOR WOMEN DEVELOPMENT

The organization bridges the gap through various programmes as Family and Women Counselling, Awareness Generation Camps, Pulse Polio Immunization Camps, Reproductive Child Health Camps, Health and Hygiene Awareness Camps, Drive against Female Foeticides, to reduce MMR and IMR, Income Generation Programmes as per the social and local norms. They are also assisted for studies and rehabilitation through financial help by providing the study materials by organizing Job Oriented Trainings to make them aware of welfare schemes.
